Introduction

This report provides the latest equalities information from Homefinder Somerset.

The data presented in this report is correct as of 19 July 2022 and relates to the main applicant for households with a Live application and those who are being considered for a property (with the status of 'Offered').

Age

Age profile of households registered with Homefinder Somerset

Half (50%) of households registered with Homefinder Somerset have a main applicant aged between 18 and 39 years old (Table 1 and Chart 1). This is significantly higher than the proportion of the Somerset population aged between 20 and 39 (21% - 2021 Census). This is perhaps not surprising as people in this age will include people most likely to be: moving to their first home, forming a relationship and seeking a place to live together, or having children and so needing a bigger home.

Somerset West & Taunton have a larger proportion of households headed by someone over 60 than the other local authorities (22% compared to 17% to 19% in the other 3 areas). These proportions are lower than for Somerset population, where people over 60 account for 32% of the population (2021 Census).



Note: The percentages refer to the proportion of households registered with a particular local authority in that with a main applicant in that Age Band (e.g. 8% of households registered with Mendip have a main applicant in the 50 - 54 year old Age Band). The percentage given for the total refers to the proportion of all households with a main applicant in that Age Band (e.g. 14% of all households have a main applicant in the 30 - 34-year-old Age Band).

Sex

Two thirds (66%) of households registered with Homefinder Somerset have a woman identified as the main applicant (Table 2 and Chart 2). This varies from 64% in Mendip and Somerset West & Taunton to 67% in Sedgemoor and South Somerset.


The proportion of households headed by a woman is significantly different to the profile of the Somerset population, where 51% of the population are female (2021 Census). The reasons for this are not clear.

Marriage and Civil Partnership

Just over a quarter (28%) of households included a joint applicant reported as 'partner' to the main applicant (Table 3). Mendip had a slightly lower proportion (25%) than the other 3 local authority areas.

Important note: The remaining data below relates to the 6,019 households who had completed a new application or updated an existing application between 2 August 2021 (when the new IT system went live) and 19 July 2022.

Disability

Across Somerset 16% of households reported that at least 1 member of their household has a disability (Table 4). The proportion ranged from 13% of households in Somerset West & Taunton to 19% in South Somerset.

The most common disability reported was a physical disability, followed by mental health issues (Table 5). It should be noted that the data relates to one member of a household. In many cases that person will have more than 1 disability (which explains the difference between 1,713 households stating that someone in their household has a disability, and the 2,799 disabilities reported in Table 5 below). It should also be noted that a number of households include more than 1 person with a disability.

Gender reassignment

Most households (94%) reported that their gender was the same as the sex they were registered at birth. 5% of households chose not to answer this question, whilst 1% reported that their gender was not the same as the sex they were registered at birth (Table 6).

Military Status

156 applicants across Somerset who have applied or updated their application since 2 August 2021 reported that they had served in the regular British Armed Forces (Army, Navy or RAF) or British Reserve Forces. This accounted for 3% of all households (Table 7).

27 of these applicants reported that they are currently serving in the regular British Armed Forces (Army, Navy or RAF) or left in the last 5 years (Table 8). Such applicants are exempt from the local connection requirement to register with Homefinder Somerset.

20 applicants reported that they need to move because of a serious injury, medical condition (including mental health) or disability sustained as a result of their service (Table 9). 8 of these applicants reported that they are currently serving or left in the last 5 years.

Pregnancy and Maternity

As stated above, two thirds (66%) of households registered with Homefinder Somerset have a woman identified as the main applicant. 8% of these women reported that they are pregnant (Table 10). The proportion ranges from 7% of households headed by a woman in Somerset West & Taunton and South Somerset to 10% in Mendip.

Please note that data is not collected on maternity (the period of 26 weeks after the birth, which reflects the period of a woman's ordinary maternity leave entitlement from employment)

Ethnic Origin

Most households (86%) are headed by main applicants who describe their ethnic origin as White British. This varies from 84% in Somerset West & Taunton to 88% in Mendip and Sedgemoor (Table 12). This is lower than proportion of the Somerset population (95% - 2011 Census).

The next most common ethnic group is White Other at 6%.

Somerset West & Taunton has a lower proportion of main applicants describing themselves as White (89% compared to 94% in the other 3 local authority areas), but this is accounted for by a higher proportion of applicants who preferred not to answer this question (8% compared to 3% in the other 3 local authority areas).

Religion or Belief

Most applicants (59%) stated that they had no religion. This varied from 57% in Somerset West & Taunton and South Somerset to 63% in Mendip and Sedgemoor. A quarter of applicants described themselves as Christian, whilst 8% preferred not to answer this question.

Sexual Orientation

Most applicants (86%) described themselves as heterosexual. This proportion ranged from 82% in Somerset West & Taunton to 88% in Sedgemoor and South Somerset, although Somerset West & Taunton saw a higher proportion of applicants who preferred not to answer this question than the other 3 local authority areas (12% compared to 6% or 7%). This proportion is lower than the 94% for the UK population as a whole (<u>Annual Population Survey 2019</u>).

The proportion of applicants who identified as lesbian, gay or bisexual was 5%, nearly double that for the UK population as a whole (2.7% - <u>Annual Population Survey 2019</u>).
