#### Introduction

This report provides the latest key information from Homefinder Somerset.

### **Households registered with Homefinder Somerset**

The number of households registered with Homefinder Somerset fell by 196 (2%) to 9,099 between 1 April and 4 July 2021.

The proportion of households in Gold Band varies from 7% in Mendip and Sedgemoor to 10% in South Somerset. The proportion of households in the Silver Band is very similar in 3 of the 4 local authorities (37-38%), whilst Mendip has a higher proportion (51%). The proportion of households in Bronze Band ranges from 41% in Mendip to 56% in Sedgemoor.

Note: The percentages refer to the proportion of households who are in that Band (e.g. 8% of all households are in Gold Band). The percentage given for the total refers to the proportion of all households registered with a particular local authority (e.g. 24% of households are registered with Sedgemoor DC).

It can be seen from Table 2 that the number of households registered with Homefinder Somerset has increased by 11% since Q4 2016/17. As reported in previous reports, the increase had been much higher due to the growth in the register in Somerset West & Taunton, caused by the local authority being unable to undertake the renewals process due to transformation and merger of the 2 local authorities. However, the impact of the work undertaken by Somerset West & Taunton to review the register can be seen very clearly from Table 2.

Half of all households registered with Homefinder Somerset need a 1 bed home, whilst 29% need a 2 bed home.

#### **Bidding Analysis**

Table 4 below shows the proportion of households by local authority and Band who are considered to be inactive (e.g. they have not bid or logged onto the Homefinder Somerset website during the last 6 months). This analysis excludes those households who have only registered in the last month and may not have had the opportunity to bid or login to the website.

The data reveals that 22% of households registered with Homefinder Somerset can be considered as inactive. The proportion of inactive households varies by Band and local authority. The proportion of inactive households ranges from 13% in South Somerset to 32% in Somerset West & Taunton. Similarly, the proportion of inactive households in Gold Band ranges from 6% in South Somerset to 22% in Somerset West & Taunton.

Table 5 shows that an average of 65 bids were placed for the 666 homes advertised in letting cycles that ended between 1 April and 30 June 2021. This number is very similar to the average number of bids for homes advertised in 2020/21 (64).

The average number of bids varied considerably between local authority areas and property type/size. The average number of bids for houses (102) was more than twice than that for flats (43). This difference can be even more marked. For example, in Sedgemoor there was an average of 165 bids for 2 bed houses compared to an average of only 28 bids for 2 bed flats.

The average number of bids for homes advertised during the quarter ranged from 53 bids in South Somerset (289 homes advertised) to 79 in Somerset West & Taunton (153 homes advertised).

Nearly 1 in 5 homes (127) advertised during the last quarter received over 100 bids. The highest number of bids received was 391, for a 2 bed house in Taunton.

#### **Homes Let**

522 homes across Somerset were set to let<sup>1</sup> between 1 April and 30 June.

Tables 6 and 7 set out the profile of the homes let in the last quarter by size, local authority and landlord. 41% of homes let in the last guarter were 1 bed or studio homes and 43% were 2 bed homes. South Somerset again accounted for the highest number of homes let (176).

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Abri (25%), Somerset West & Taunton (17%), Aster (12%), Homes in Sedgemoor (12%), Magna (9%), LiveWest (7%) and Stonewater (7%) together accounted for 90% of homes let in the last quarter.

Tables 8 and 9 show that 41% of homes were let to households in the Gold band, whilst 46% were let to households in Silver Band. The proportion of homes let to households in the Gold Band varied from 38% of homes in South Somerset to 42% of homes in Mendip. 42% of homes were let in the last quarter were let to households in the Silver band. The proportion of homes let to households in the Silver Band ranged from 41% of homes in Somerset West & Taunton to 54% in Mendip.

The proportion of homes let to applicants in Gold Band amongst the 7 landlords who let the most homes in the last quarter also varied by landlord (Table 10), from 35% for Stonewater to 46% for Homes in Sedgemoor.
