#### Introduction

This report provides the latest key information from Homefinder Somerset.

#### **Households registered with Homefinder Somerset**

The number of households registered with Homefinder Somerset increased by 429 (5%) to 9,528 between 4 July and 13 October 2021. All 4 local authorities saw an increase in the number of households registered but the increase over the quarter ranged from 1% in Sedgemoor to 8% in Mendip.

The proportion of households in Gold Band varies from 6% in Mendip and Sedgemoor to 9% in South Somerset. The proportion of households in Silver Band is similar in 3 of the 4 local authorities (36 - 37%), whilst Mendip has a higher proportion (52%). The proportion of households in Bronze Band ranges from 42% in Mendip to 57% in Somerset West & Taunton.

Note: The percentages refer to the proportion of households who are in that Band (e.g. 7% of all households are in Gold Band). The percentage given for the total refers to the proportion of all households registered with a particular local authority (e.g. 23% of households are registered with Sedgemoor DC).

It can be seen from Table 2 and Chart 1 that the number of households registered with Homefinder Somerset has increased by 16% since Q4 2016/17. As stated in previous reports, the increase had been much higher due to the growth in the register in Somerset West & Taunton, caused by the local authority being unable to undertake the renewals process due to transformation and merger of the 2 local authorities. It can be seen from Chart 1 that there have been increases in 3 local authority areas since Q4 2016/17 but a fall in South Somerset.

Chart 1: Number of households registered by local authority. Q4 2016/17 as the base




Table 3 shows that just over half of all households registered with Homefinder Somerset need a 1 bed home, whilst 30% need a 2 bed home.

#### **Bidding Analysis**

Between 1 July and 30 September, a total of 37,049 bids were placed on homes across Somerset. This is down from the previous quarter because no homes were advertised in the last week of July due to the IT transfer. Chart 2 shows the number of bids placed each month. The 2 big dips in the number of bids placed each month shown on the chart are due to the 2 national lockdowns.

Table 4 below shows the proportion of households by local authority and Band who have not bid or logged into the Homefinder Somerset website since the transfer to the Locata system on 2 August 2021.

The table reveals that 40% of households registered with Homefinder Somerset have not bid or logged into the Homefinder Somerset website since 2 August 2021. Some of these applicants will have recently joined the register, but work is continuing with those applicants who were transferred from the previous IT system to encourage them to log into the new website. These applicants have been advised that if they do not log into the Homefinder Somerset website within a month, their application will be closed.

Table 5 reveals that an average of 61 bids were placed for the 392 homes advertised between 2 August and 30 September 2021.

The average number of bids varied considerably between local authority areas and property type/size. The average number of bids for houses (91) was more than twice than that for flats (39). This difference can be even more marked. For example, in Somerset West & Taunton there was an average of 123 bids for 2 bed houses compared to an average of only 25 bids for 2 bed flats.

The average number of bids for homes advertised ranged from 45 bids in South Somerset (132 homes advertised) to 81 in Somerset West & Taunton (102 homes advertised).

97 homes (25%) advertised between 2 August and 30 September received over 100 bids. The highest number of bids received was 241, for a 2 bed house in Taunton.



#### **Homes Let**

577 homes across Somerset were set to let<sup>1</sup> between 1 July and 30 September, up from 522 in the previous quarter.

Tables 6 and 7 set out the profile of the homes let in the last quarter by size, local authority, and landlord. 42% of homes let in the last quarter were 1 bed and 40% were 2 bed homes. South Somerset again accounted for the highest number of homes let (213).

Abri (19%), Homes in Sedgemoor (15%), Somerset West & Taunton (13%), LiveWest (12%). Stonewater (12%), Magna (10%) and Sanctuary (10%) together accounted for 92% of homes let in the last quarter.

Tables 8 and 9 show that 45% of homes were let to households in the Gold band, up from 41% in the last quarter. The proportion of homes let to households in the Gold Band varied from 43% of homes in Mendip and South Somerset to 49% of homes in Sedgemoor. 42% of homes were let in the last quarter were let to households in the Silver band. This ranged from 34% of homes in Sedgemoor to 50% in Mendip.

The proportion of homes let to applicants in Gold Band amongst the 8 landlords who let the most homes in the last quarter also varied by landlord (Table 9), from 37% for Stonewater to 69% for Sanctuary.
